

## Directions to WLGA European Office - Wales House,

### Rond-Point Schuman 11, B-1040 Brussels

#### From Brussels International Airport:

##### By taxi:

There is a taxi rank with official licensed Brussels city taxis (blue/yellow emblem) outside the Arrivals Hall. A taxi to Wales House should cost around €25-€30. Further information may be found [here](#).

##### By bus:

The bus station is located on level 0 – one floor down from the Arrivals Hall. The STIB Brussels Airport Line is a 40 minute express service between the Airport and the European Quarter. For the airport, the **Schuman bus stop** is just across *Avenue de Cortenberg* from the corner of Wales House. For Wales House, the **Schuman bus stop** is in front of the European Commission Berlaymont building on *Rue Archimede*.

From Monday to Friday 8pm the Airport Line carries the **Number 12** and serves the major stops. On weekdays after 8pm, on Saturday, Sunday, and holidays the Airport Line carries the **Number 21** and serves all stops. The ticket for one journey is €4. Further information may be found [here](#).

##### By train:

The Airport train station is located below the terminal (basement level -1). Up to four trains an hour connect the airport to Brussels North, Central and Midi stations. Further information may be found [here](#).

#### From Brussels Gare du Midi/Zuidstation (Eurostar):

##### By taxi:

There is a taxi rank with official licensed Brussels city taxis (blue/yellow emblem) outside Midi station. A taxi to Wales House should cost around €10-€15.

##### By Metro:

The Metro is two floors below the Eurostar Arrivals Hall. Take the **Number 2** Line or **Number 6** Line (Simonis) and exit at **Arts-Loi/Kunst-Wet** (*six stops from Midi*). Take the **Number 1** Line (Stockel/Stokkel) or the **Number 5** Line (Herrmann-Debroux) and exit at **Schuman** (*two stops from Arts-Loi*). A single ticket costs €1-70.
